KADIAN/MORPHINE SULFATE ER CAPSULES

Effective September 5, 2012, the generic morphine sulfate ER <u>tablets</u> will be preferred over Kadian and the generic morphine sulfate ER <u>capsules</u>. Capsules will require a prior authorization and clinical documentation supporting the medical necessity of the use of the capsules instead of the tablets.

SINGULAIR

Effective October 1, 2012, **BRAND NAME SINGULAIR** will *no longer be preferred*. Wyoming Medicaid will *now prefer* the **generic montelukast**.
