SUBOXONE EMERGENCY SUPPLY

Effective Wednesday, May 22, 2019, the State of Wyoming will now allow one six (6) day emergency supply per month for Suboxone Films or buprenorphine/naloxone tablets when a prior authorization is required. The six (6) day emergency supply will be allowed to process in the point-of-sale system by using a PA Type Code of "2" and a PA # of "8". DISCOUNT CARDS

As a reminder, Medicaid clients who present discount cards at the pharmacy MAY NOT use those discount cards in conjunction with their Medicaid benefits. Discount cards cannot be used on any prescriptions that are paid for in whole or in part by any government program regardless of the presence or absence of such a statement on the card itself. Claims that have been "split-billed" in this fashion are subject to subsequent recovery and possible future audit proceedings. Wyoming Medicaid is requesting pharmacies closely review client profiles as the BIN # associated with many primary insurance cards is the same as the BIN # on many discount cards.
