COVID-19 VACCINE SUBMISSION INFORMATION

Effective February 16, 2021, Wyoming Medicaid will allow NCPDP D.0 compliant claims for COVID-19 vaccines to process through the pharmacy POS system. Properly submitted claims will be reimbursed at a rate of \$22.67 for the immunization claim for each vaccine series in eligible clients age 16 years of age and older. Please review the following submission requirements for the currently available vaccines:

- The Days' Supply (405-D5) populated with a value of "1."
- The DUR/PPS segment (440-E5) of the submitted claim should have "MA" (Medication Administered)
- The Quantity Dispensed (442-E7) should be populated with the quantity in mL of administered; "0.3" for vaccines manufactured by Pfizer, Inc. and "0.5" for those manufactured by Moderna, Inc.
- Incentive Amount Submitted (438-E3) should include the amount the pharmacy is seeking for reimbursement. This value must be submitted and be greater than 0. All claims will be reimbursed at the aforementioned \$22.67 regardless of the amount submitted.
- Submission Clarification Code (420-DK) should contain:
 - "2" (Other Override) to indicate the first dose of multi-dose vaccine or
 - "6" (Starter Dose) to indicate the second dose of multi-dose vaccine
- Basis of Cost Determination submitted should be submitted with a value of "15" to indicate free product or no associated cost.

Claims that are submitted using the above criteria will be accepted with no further action required by the pharmacy.
